Definite article: the

The articles define a name and are always placed by the beginning of the noun. In English, articles don't have a gender. The article "the" can be used either in singular or plural. So "the" is English for: "el, la, los, las".

Examples:

- the boy (el niño)
- the girl (la niña)
- the books (los libros)
- the tables (las mesas)

Indefinite article: a, an

- It is used before a noun to express that it is general or not specified.
- It can also be used instead of 1. This article doesn't have gender, either.

Rules to use the indefinite article:

1. "A" is used with nouns that start with a consonant.

Examples:

- a book (un libro)
- a chair (una silla)

2. "An" is used with nouns that start with a vowel.

Examples:

- an example (un ejemplo)
- an orange (una naranja).

3. Exceptions:

- a university
- a euro
- an hour
- a hospital

This has to do with pronunciation rather than the spelling of the word.
