			<b>They=their</b>

**Possessive adjectives** are use to modify the **noun** following it in order to show **possession**.

### Statement with be

#### 1. I + verb be

I am a soccer fan

#### 2. You + verb be

You are a football fan.

#### 3. He + verb be

He is a detective .

#### 4. We + verb be

We are a big family.

#### 5. They + verb be

They are tennis player.

#### 6. It + verb be

It is a great building

### Possesive adjectives

#### My+ noun+ verb be

My favorite soccer  
Player is Yasser.

#### Your + noun + verb be

Your favorite sport is  
Football.

#### His +noun + verb be

His work is hard.

#### Our + noun + verb be

Our family is great.

#### Their + noun + verb be

Their matches are  
Exciting.

#### Its + noun + verb be

Its design is cool.
